- 4. The Sub-ordinate Civil Courts will enjoy either the holidays declared by the High Court or the holidays declared by the State Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh on the same occasion falling on two different dates.
- 5. During the year, the staff can avail any 2 (two) days Restricted Holidays from the above listed R/H with prior approval of the concerned Head.
